

Animal Care

The St George's Animal Care programme is run on a 3 tier system in order for all students to be able to access their learning and gain accreditation at the appropriate level. Students learn all about how to, appropriately, care for a range of small animals and pets, with hands on experience being gained through interaction with the school pets, and visits to pet stores and the college. Students organise all the care for the school animals including liaising with the Vets in order to ensure the ongoing health of the animals. Students will also have the opportunity to build the range of animals in school, by doing research and carrying out surveys within school.

Students will also gain an understanding of how farm animals, horses and donkeys are cared for, fed and housed through external visits to appropriate venues.
